

OAR Scholarships

OAR proudly presents 2 scholarships that offer \$3,000 non-renewable awards to support students with ASD pursuing full-time, post-secondary, undergraduate education or vocational-technical training in any of the following:

- Two-year and four-year college or university
- Trade, technical, or vocational school
- Cooperative life skills programs

Students may apply for the Schwallie Family Scholarship or the Lisa Higgins Hussman Scholarship.

OAR Grants

Since 2002, OAR has awarded over \$3 million in grants to support applied autism research. Interested researchers are encouraged to apply.

Graduate Research Grant Program

Grant awards up to \$1,000 for Master's candidates, and up to \$2,000 for Doctoral or Post-Doctoral candidates.

Applied Research Competition

Grant awards up to \$30,000 for pilot studies that range from 1-2 years in duration.
